We all benefit from taking a holiday & enjoying a change of scenery or routine but sometimes it's hard to slow down & adjust to the freedom a break can bring. 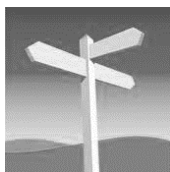
