"WWW"

"WWW" is now universally known as shorthand for the "world wide web" – but some years ago I attended a course entitled "WWW. BB" – in that case it was short for "When women will be Bishops" and was a leadership course – that's what took me along with lots of you to Westminster Abbey Evensong on the 10th anniversary of 9/11. I can also remember one Advent preaching about "WWW" "Waiting- Wondering – Worshipping – though on the day I preached that sermon- it was more a case of "wild- wet- wintry".

More recently I have been learning about another interpretation of – this time "WWW" – interpreted as **"Welcome"** **"Worship"** **"Word"** and **"Witness"** – these form the structure for small groups meeting as part of the **Lightwave** initiative launched at the cathedral last month on Pentecost Sunday. **Lightwave** is the name of the newly established Fresh Expressions Community – which is made up of small missional groups, who are open in their **Welcome** to all- and perhaps most especially people who are new to the Christian faith- enabling them to **Worship** in a style in which they feel at home- introducing them to and exploring with them God's **Word** – which then enables them to be able to **Witness** to God in their lives. We have a special connection with this initiative as the **Lightwave** support team is based at Otley College. Some of us have already got to know Sally Gaze, the Archdeacon for Rural Mission, who lives in Playford and sometimes worships with us in Grundisburgh- our welcome must now extend to the team as it grows and develops this outreach to the 96% of people who don't have any involvement with the Christian faith or church.

These key words are not exclusive to **Lightwave**, they form a great structure for all of us in our churches and the activities in which we are involved.

Some of you will know the hymn, which is one of my favourites **"All are Welcome"**

Let us build a house
where love can dwell
And all can safely live,
A place where saints and children tell
How hearts learn to forgive.

Built of hopes and dreams and visions,
Rock of faith and vault of grace;
Here the love of Christ shall end divisions;

Let us build a house where prophets speak,
And words are strong and true,
Where all God's children dare to seek
To dream God's reign anew.

Here the cross shall stand as witness
And a symbol of God's grace;
Here as one we claim the faith of Jesus:
