If she dies before 17 then to Dorothy and Prudence Burch, my brother Robert Burch's two daughters £5 each. To Mary Burch my brother George Burch's daughter, £5 at 21. To Hannah Burch and Joseph Burch mybrother William Burch's children £5 each at 21. To Mary Burch my brother Steven's daughter £10, at 21. To Elizabeth Burch daughter of Baszaeall Burch my brother £10.

Henry moved to Grundisburgh following death of his wife and retirement. It is said that the had never spent a night away from Manor Farm.


