late of 53 King Street, Walton, Felixstowe, Suffolk.

To the Rector and Church Wardens for the time being of the Clopton Parish Church the sum of Five Hundred Pounds towards the restoration of the bells in memory of my parents JAMES WILLIAM and LOUISA FUTTER or for such other purposes in connection with the said Church as the Rector and Church Wardens shall in their absolute discretion think fit and I declare that the receipt of the said Rector and Church Wardens shall be a sufficient discharge to my trustees for the said sum and that my trustees shall not be bound to see to or inquire into the application and I further declare that the said Rector and Church Wardens or their respective successors shall be entitled at any time to expend the whole capital of the said sum in manner aforesaid.
